Audition Procedure

Entry to the Advanced Diploma is in the first instance by means of a prepared audition.

Applicants will be supplied with a booklet of short speeches drawn from a range of contemporary and classic stage plays from which they must choose two to present before a panel of the teaching staff.

Applicants will be seen in groups of 12-15. After an initial physical and vocal warm-up led by a staff member, applicants will be asked to present their first prepared piece to the audition panel. After all the first pieces have been seen the panel will then ask for each auditionee's second prepared piece.

On the basis of these performances applicants may be asked to prepare a third piece for a subsequent call-back audition.

Following the call-back audition selected applicants will be asked to attend an interview with the Director of the School and key faculty members where their ideas and aspirations will be discussed in detail and material supporting their application presented. Places in the course will be offered following these interviews.

Applicants are encouraged to have as much fun as possible in the audition so that they are seen to advantage. Applicants should not seek audition coaching as individual choices and qualities are an essential part of the assessment process.

Applicants should not involve elaborate props and costumes and wear loose comfortable clothing and sensible footwear.
